Celebrating its 20th year in 2010, the Australian Festival of Chamber Music (AFCM) is an international chamber music Festival held over 9 days each July in Townsville, North Queensland. Each year, the AFCM attracts between 25 and 30 chamber musicians from around the world, appearing in over 25 concerts performing 80 compositions along with 20 emerging artists.

It is Australia's largest festival dedicated to chamber music. Besides the core concert series, the AFCM has a number of other key components focusing on music, entertainment, education, community outreach and the environment. Some of these include the Winterschool masterclass education programme; the Young Families Concert; the Reef Talk Series; the Outback Tour and the Chefs in the North Dinner.
