The Chamber Music Festival began in 1992 with an enthusiastic group of friends performing five concerts in five days in Nelson. Two years later the Nelson Music Festival Trust was founded to secure the Festival's future and administer its affairs. The Adam Foundation was welcomed as the Principal Sponsor in 1997 and the Festival continues to enjoy the Foundation's generous support.

The New Zealand String Quartet is the Festival's Ensemble-in-Residence, and over the years many celebrated New Zealand and international artists have performed in the Festival including Piers Lane, Anton Kuerti, Peter Nagy, Michael Houstoun, Diedre Irons, Nobuko Imai, Frans Helmerson, Colin Carr, Richard Nunns, Michelangelo String Quartet, Goldner String Quartet, and New Zealand Trio.

The Festival is a unique, biennial summer event where professional musicians from New Zealand and overseas collaborate to perform great music in the captivating settings of Nelson and the Tasman region. The Adam Chamber Music Festival in Nelson is New Zealand's national chamber music festival and runs over a two-week period at the end of January/beginning of February.

During the Festival Nelson is transformed into an exclusive and international centre for fine music. Leading performers from inside and outside New Zealand join the New Zealand String Quartet, Ensemble-in-Residence, in performing the best of chamber music in a charming environment. Linds Taylor in the Dominion Post declared it “the best classical music festival in New Zealand – sixteen full days of music. Some of us could not live without it.”

As with all arts organisations in New Zealand, the Adam Chamber Music Festival runs on a tight budget and relies on the goodwill of a great many people to make it happen – sponsors, musicians, volunteers, concert-goers. However, although the Festival has been an outstanding success, the costs of classical music presentation are increasingly difficult to meet from box office and external funding.

Rather than raise admission prices beyond the pockets of some music-lovers, the Nelson Festival Music Trust, the Festival's administrator, is initiating a donor programme with tiered levels of donation and related benefits which, it hopes, will enable many people to make a contribution.
