

We invite you to support New Zealand's pre-eminent biennial Adam Cahmber Music Festival..


As music-lovers, our audiences are central to this total immersion into creativity, revelling in the frisson created by a shared passion for chamber music between those onstage and those in the auditorium.



Ensuring Success

Established for over 25 years, the festival has enjoyed many years of success however we rely on support from funding bodies, sponsors and espcailly donors to achive a postive fiscal outcome and remain sustainable.

We recognise that it has been a very challenging time and that the current economic climate has taken its toll on many. To help make a donation contribution more viable, we have the option of payment in two or four instalments leading up to the 2024 event. Current legislation provides a 33.3% tax credit on all donations to our trust (excluding value of complimentary tickets).


